Kuratorium Preußischer Kulturbesitz is promoting the exhibition “Bewegte Zeiten. Archäologie in Deutschland“ (“Restless Times. Archaeology in Germany”)

Berlin, 20th September 2018

Within the framework of the strategic partnership with the Stiftung Preußischer Kulturbesitz (Prussian Cultural Heritage Foundation), the Kuratorium Preußischer Kulturbesitz (Board of the Prussian Cultural Heritage Foundation) is promoting the exhibition “Bewegte Zeiten. Archäologie in Deutschland” of the Museum für Vor- und Frühgeschichte (Museum of Prehistory and Early History) of the Staatliche Museen zu Berlin (National Museums in Berlin), which will be shown from 21st September 2018 to 6th January 2019.

Exceptional archaeological finds such as the Bronze Age Nebra Sky Disk, 3000-year-old gold hats or the harbour wall of Roman Cologne will be presented in an area of 1600 square metres on the ground floor of the Gropius Bau in Berlin. The high-quality exhibits come from a total of 70 lenders from all over Germany and will be made accessible to the visitors in four thematic focus areas.

Thorsten Strauß, Deutsche Bank AG, Chairman of the Kuratorium Preußischer Kulturbesitz: “In addition to other areas of focus, the Kuratorium is also promoting exhibition projects of the Staatliche Museen zu Berlin. The exhibition “Restless Times. Archaeology in Germany” is making an important contribution to the European Year of Cultural Heritage. By presenting spectacular finds from the Stone Age up to the present day, it impressively documents what human beings have been occupying themselves with for thousands of years: the core themes mobility, exchange, conflict and innovation were just as relevant a long time ago as they are today. It is fascinating to experience how much knowledge has been – in the true sense of the word – dug out and brought together here in an exciting way. We are delighted to support the exhibition and we hope there will be a great many visitors!”
